3 Principles of Disposing Trash

1 The correct type of trash

2on the correct day 3 in the correct location Basic Rules

- Dispose of burnable (except branches and leaves) and landfill waste using designated trash bags.
- •Use a clear plastic bag up to 45L to dispose of recyclables, PET bottles, Hazardous waste(special waste), leaves, branches, plastic wrapping and containers. \*Do not put bundled branches, papers or bicycles in plastic bags.
- Anything that does not fit in a designated trash bag is large size waste and must be paid for.
- Dispose of trash by 8:30AM on the designated collection day.
- •Please refer to the trash and recycling calendar regarding trash collection on holidays and during New Year's.

- \* Paper cups, thermal paper, photographs etc should be disposed of as burnable waste.


