The SDGs are international goals extending towards 2030, adopted at the 2015 UN Summit. They are universal goals that aim to create a society in which everyone can live happily and which we can pass on to future generations. Fair trade practices are directly and indirectly related to all of the SDGs. Kumamoto City was certified as an "SDGs Future City" in 2019.



Ethical Consumption

Ethical consumption means choosing products considerate of "people," "society," and the "environment" when purchasing goods. Fair trade practices also lead to ethical consumption.

As a Fair Trade City, Kumamoto City also encourages <u>fair trade that supports the local</u> <u>community</u>, whether environmental activities, local production for local consumption, or support for people with disabilities.
