

Checklist for Patients Who Must Be Admitted to a Hospital Due to Coronavirus Symptoms

Necessary Documents for the Hospital Admission

- Patient Registration Card (for those who have one)
- All of your health insurance cards
- Your *Inkan* seal (for those who have one)

Things You Will Need During Your Stay

- Cellphone
 - Cellphone charger
 - Medicines you are currently taking & your prescription record booklet
 - Underwear (you may not be able to use a washing machine depending on the hospital, so please bring a lot.)
 - Pajamas or loungewear
 - Slippers for indoor use
 - 2 to 3 bottles of tea or water (There are hospitals where you can purchase more after you have been admitted. However, some hospitals require that the staff go to buy it for you, so it may be difficult to buy more right after you are admitted.)
 - Electronic devices: earphones (to watch the TV)
 - Other everyday items: toothbrush, toothpaste, tissues, towels, bath towels, laundry detergent, laundry drying hangers, toiletries (shampoo, conditioner, body soap, etc.), cups, glasses, contacts, hearing aids, dentures, shaving razor, menstruation hygiene products, hairdryer, etc.
 - Masks (non-fabric)
- ※ You will not be allowed to enter with cutlery or other dangerous objects.
- ※ While you are admitted, managing your valuables is your own personal responsibility. You will need enough money to buy water and other necessary items while you are in the hospital and return home via public transportation, but please don't bring a lot of cash with you.
- ※ You will spend almost all your time in your room. Please bring only as much personal baggage as you can carry by yourself.
- ※ You cannot choose the type of room you will stay in. There is a chance that you will have to share a large room with multiple patients. Thank you for your understanding.
- ※ After you are discharged from the hospital, please return home on your own. If you will need to use public transportation, please prepare the fare yourself.

About Visiting

- Currently, all forms of visiting patients in the hospital is prohibited.
- All objects delivered by friends or family should be given to the hospital first, and then the staff will give them to the patients. Please talk with the hospital about the day you plan to bring the items. (Anyone who's health is being monitored, such as confirmed close contacts, cannot come to the hospital.)
